What were the events surrounding those two times like? What happened? What caused that? What role did your own conscious choice play? What people brought you up? What people took you down? Is there a pattern to these type of events in your life?

Read: - Psalm 107:8-9

Do you make time to praise God in your daily life? If so how does that effect you?

What is one good thing God has filled you with this morning?

Read: - Ecclesiastes 1:2

This is a popular refrain throughout the entire book of Ecclesiastes, what do you think it means? Why is it important for the Preacher to continue to emphasize this point?

READ - Ecclesiastes 2:4-11, Ecclesiastes 5:10

There is a universal appeal to seeking these things to fill our longings and our needs. There is also a universal sense that these things are unable to do that. Why do we desire things that can't bring satisfaction?

Do you have any experience with that? Can you share?

READ - Ecclesiastes 11:9

What is driving this verse? Why do you think the author thought it important enough to include?

Read: Ecclesiastes 12:1-7, Ecclesiastes 12:13-14

When you read the Preacher's final conclusion, what would you add? What would you take away?

What is one way you can apply your life to these passages this week?
